# NEWS FROM THE STATE ENGINEER'S OFFICE

## JIM GODDARD, PG—UTAH DIVISION OF WATER RIGHTS

### CHANGES AT THE DIVISION OF WATER RIGHTS

Lee Sim has retired after 38 years of service to the State. Jared Manning is the new Assistant State Engineer over Field Services (Well Drilling, Distribution, Adjudication, and Enforcement). Jared moves to Field Services from the Technical Services section of the Division.

### NEW WATER WELL HANDBOOK

The revisions to the Administrative Rules for Water Wells (Section R655-4 UAC) became effective on May 1, 2011. The primary revision to the Rules included the addition of pump installer licensing and the regulation of pump installation and repair work. The revised rules have been incorporated into a new handbook which is available now on our website at [www.waterrights.utah.gov/wellinfo](http://www.waterrights.utah.gov/wellinfo). Please discard the old 2008 version of the handbook (yellow cover) and replace it with this new 2011 version. The new handbook has a light purple cover. The new handbooks have been sent out to all licensees and registered operators. If you did not receive one or need additional copies, please contact the Division.

**Pump Installation Report (Pump Log):** With the additional of pump installer licensing and pump installation regulation, a pump installation report (pump log) must now be filed upon completion of regulated pump activity. Since permitting and start cards are not required for pump work, the pump log is freely available for printing and copying as needed. Licensees may request hard copies of the blank pump log form from our Office. The pump log form is also available on our website. The online pump log can be printed and filled out by hand, or it can be filled out online, then printed and signed. The pump log can be linked from our "Forms" page, the main "Well" page, and from the "Well Database" page. ([www.waterrights.utah.gov/forms/pumpInstallReport.pdf](http://www.waterrights.utah.gov/forms/pumpInstallReport.pdf))

### OTHER DIVISION OF WATER RIGHTS WEBSITE ENHANCEMENTS

The Division has recently incorporated Google Earth technology into our map server queries. This technology makes it easier to maneuver around on the map and incorporates the same features as Google Earth.

The Non-Production Well (NPW) application and approval process, including the form, have been updated to take into account recent changes to the well rules ([www.waterrights.utah.gov/forms/nonProdWell.asp](http://www.waterrights.utah.gov/forms/nonProdWell.asp)). Additional information fields have been added to the form including new well types, project address, and project parcel number. A link to our location calculator was also added to the NPW location entry section of the form. The form must be completed and signed by the project owner or authorized representative and should not be signed by the licensed driller. The Division now has up to 14-days to review the NPW application. Moreover, new unapproved NPW applications, as well as approved applications, will be listed on our website during this review period so that the public has the ability to obtain and review the information for proposed NPW projects.


Our licensee and operator database has also been enhanced to take into account the addition of pump installers and registered pump rig operators. The database now allows separate listings for licensed pump installers. For those who are licensed both as a driller and pump installer, you would show up on both lists.

### REGULATORY REMINDERS

For cathodic protection wells, a licensed driller must be utilized to drill and construct these types of wells. Regarding this requirement, it is important to note that the placement of anodes, coke breeze, vent tubes, and seals in a regulated cathodic protection well must be overseen by a licensed driller. In some cases, the licensed driller has been asked to leave after the borehole is constructed, and the remainder of the well is constructed by the unlicensed contractor or engineering company. The licensed driller must oversee all down-hole phases of cathodic protection well construction.

When ordering up sand-cement grout for a well seal from a batch plant using a "bag mix" description, it is important to specify a recipe that meets the State standard. The standard for sand-cement grout is a grout consisting of equal parts of cement conforming to ASTM standard C150 and sand/aggregate with no more than six (6) gallons of water per 94 pound sack (one cubic foot) of cement. Using a "bag mix" description to meet this standard, the mix must be at least a 14.8 bag mix. That is, at least 14.8 standard sacks of cement must be used in the mix with equal amounts of sand to make a cubic yard of grout. A 14.8 bag mix will include equal amounts of cement and sand (about 1400 pounds of each) mixed with no more than 6 gallons of water per standard bag to form a cubic yard of grout. A common mix used in the past has been a 12-bag mix. This mix includes considerably more sand than cement, which would not meet the State requirement.

From "What's New" by the Utah Geological Survey:

### **Utah Has Two Wives, and Other Interesting Geographic Facts**

It sounds like a bad joke: What has 29 Bars, 69 Devils, and 13 Heavens? Utah does. Those are part of the names of geographic features found throughout the state. The topic of interesting names was recently tackled by the Utah Geological Survey (UGS) in its "Glad You Asked" section of *Survey Notes*.

"Utah has more bars than Arizona, Nevada and Wyoming combined," said Mark Milligan, a UGS geologist. Bars, in this case, are elongated ridges of sand, gravel or other sediment.

Utah beats other states by having 'Wife' in the name of two locations. Utah's 69 Devils are trumped by God and Jesus, which total 1,163 combined. However, Hell is found 55 times, but Heaven only 13.

There are 104 'Strange' names and 311 'Odd' names in the United States, but surprisingly none are in Utah. But Utah is swell having one of only 12 'Swell' places across the U.S.
