






Letter From The President Richard Petersen

Fact Sheet for Water Discharges from Drilling Operations

Updated June 2025

Background

Utah Administrative Code (UAC) R317-8-2 requires a Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) permit for the discharge of pollutants from any point source into a Water of the State. Well drilling operations are not exempt from this requirement. Well drilling operations that require discharging into waters, including all surface water, (such as storm drains, ditches, channels, wetlands), or groundwater, must obtain coverage to discharge before initiating these activities.

Permit Coverage Options

Several permitting options may apply to well drilling discharges based on discharge type and location. Permit options include:

- Construction Dewatering Hydrostatic Testing General Permit Covers the discharges of uncontaminated groundwater or surface water from activities such as construction, pipeline testing, and drinking water vessel disinfection to surface water.
- Treated Groundwater Surface Water General Permit Covers the discharge of treated groundwater
 or surface water that contains pollutants other than what is usually encountered by construction
 operations to surface water.
- Individual Permits- Covers discharges to a surface water that can not be covered under a UPDES General Permit. These are written specifically to the project and receiving waterbody.
- **Groundwater Discharge Permits** Covers the discharge of pollutants to ground water. UAC R317-6-6.2 provides guidance on groundwater pollutant concentrations and permitting requirements.
- **Permit by Rule Facilities** Covers discharges to groundwater that will meet groundwater quality standards, where the impacts have been determined to be de-minimus by DWQ.




